In CFS 7, senior is completely dependent except feeding.

Senior will be depend on the use of wheelchair both at home and in the community.

- Which of the following statement(s) are CORRECT for Merdeka Generation (MG) seniors receiving PAssion Silver Card? (Tick all that applies)
 - PAssion Silver Card top up for eligible MG seniors has been extended to existing PGs.
